

## Credit Union Examiner Job Description

The State of Iowa Division of Credit Unions has an open position for a credit union examiner in the Des Moines, Cedar Rapids, or Iowa City area. The responsibilities will include on-site regulatory examination and general supervision of Iowa chartered credit unions to determine their financial condition, conformance with applicable statutes, and reasonableness in managerial policies. Examiners will be required to prepare written summaries of areas reviewed, regulatory findings, and corrective action needed. Meetings are then scheduled with management and the Board of Directors to discuss findings. **This position requires 35% overnight travel within Iowa.**

The qualified applicant will have:

- Bachelor's degree in accounting, finance, or business administration;
- Investment / ALM experience;
- Exceptional communication skills, both verbal and written;
- Excellent problem solving and decision making skills;
- Ability to complete 100% of assignments on time; and
- Proficient knowledge of Microsoft Word, Excel, and Outlook.

The following are considered a plus:

- Familiarity in maintaining and /or reviewing ALM models;
- Prior experience working in the credit union or banking industry;
- Experience working in a specialized area in a financial institution.
